As the summer draws to a close and you prepare to return to work, we are providing you with this brief update.

Provincial Negotiations

APSSP Provincial members, with our EWAO-ATEO partners, have had 3 negotiations meetings with the Province's team to date, the most recent of which occurred earlier this week. Negotiations are proceeding slowly as items related to the scope of provincial bargaining continue to be discussed. These scope items determine what will be discussed directly with the government's representatives and what will be left for negotiations with local school boards. We will continue to keep you updated as information becomes available.

Until a new contract comes into force, the terms of our current contract which expires on August 31, 2019, remain in place including sick leave (fully paid, short-term and long-term) and pregnancy leave top-up provisions. Should you have any questions about this, please contact your department APSSP representative(s) for clarification.
