Call for Local Chapter Executive Nominations

This year, **all Halton Catholic Chapter Executive positions** will be open for new representation. As per the *APSSP Constitution 2017*, Local Chapter Executive Officer elections "shall be held at least once every two (2) years. All elections shall be held by secret ballot" (p. 15).

In the spirit of ensuring all member groups from the Halton Catholic Chapter receive the best possible representation, we need our Executive Council to be made up of members from each discipline. We must strive to continue supporting one another in our varied roles in order to provide the best possible services within our Board. All Executive positions are currently on a two-year term, and come with an annual Honorarium.

Any interested parties should attend the Provincial AGM on Thursday, May 17, 2018, and submit their nominations via email to the Halton Catholic Chapter President by Wednesday, May 21, 2018. Elections will occur in early June 2018.

Absenteeism

The Board has approached APSSP with instructions to remind members to take sick days only for their intended purposes. The APSSP Halton Catholic Chapter average absences for the 2016-2017 school year was above the Board average. Our current *Collective Agreement* states, "Sick leave days may be used for reasons of personal illness, personal injury, personal medical appointments, or personal dental emergencies only" (p. 9). Please ensure you use the appropriate codes and times when entering your absences into SmartFindExpress.

We encourage you to review your *Collective Agreement*, available through the APSSP website and on HCDSB StaffNet, prior to contacting your Local Chapter Executive regarding any concerns or workplace issues and challenges. (i.e., If you are returning to work following a medical leave and have concerns, we encourage you to take advantage of the invitation that will be provided by the Board to have Union representation at any return-to-work meeting). Your affiliation with APSSP ensures that you are protected under the terms of the *Collective Agreement*.
