### **Union Dues**

An increase of 0.25% to Union Dues was approved at the May 17, 2018 APSSP Annual General Meeting. Union Dues went from 1% annually to 1.25% annually effective September 1, 2018. This increase is to account for rising expenses as our Union grows, and to accommodate additional release time for Presidents and Provincial Executive members so that they may commit more time to their roles. At present, all APSSP Union Executives at both the Provincial and Local Chapter levels continue to work in their careers while also managing Union duties without salary. APSSP continues to have the lowest union dues rate of any Union in the Ontario Education Sector.
